

Three Towns, 2 Schools, 1 Show ~ FLOW Follies Presents Silly Sketches on the Complexities of Air Travel by Deb Breslow

Rehearsals are underway, sets are being designed, and advance tickets are available for the 2012 production of ***Come FLOW With Me***, a musical comedy show created by FLOW Follies. Since its inception, FLOW Follies, a volunteer parent organization, has awarded almost \$450,000 in scholarships to students in the Ramapo-Indian Hills community. Last year, \$40,000 in scholarships were awarded to 50 students (25 from each high school). Join us on March 8, 9, 10, and 11, as RIH teachers, students, and parents set stage in a fictitious airport where they encounter the foibles of air travel.

Seventy students submitted artwork for our 2012 Playbill/Ad Journal Design Contest. The winner was Jake Morgan from Indian Hills. He will receive 5 hours of community service + a \$50 gift card.
